About Us

3'Ain is a trio in which Yamen Martini (trumpet) Otto Kint (upright bass) and Piet Maris (accordion) join forces: they bring a unique blend of worldwide jazz with influences from the Levant and the Swana region (commonly known as the Southwest Asia and North Africa).

More or less 13 years ago, Yamen left Syria to arrive in Belgium in 2015, where he met Piet. After collaborating on music for a theatre play, Piet invited Yamen to join Jaune Toujours as a guest musician, as you can hear on their album *Europeana*. In the summer of 2019, Otto joined them, giving birth to 3'Ain.

The band name is based on the eighteenth letter of the Arabic alphabet, **ع**, a vowel which is said to be difficult to pronounce for western people. As it is often represented as '3' in chat and SMS conversations, and in transliteration as 'ain', **3'Ain** seemed an appropriate name for a trio playing contemporary and worldwide jazz with influences from the Levant.

With their distinctive sound, they released their first EP on the Choux de Bruxelles label in May 2020, in full Covid lockdown. The subsequent full album, 'Sea of Stories' has been released in the Spring of 2023 and has received international acclaim in the press.

They are releasing a new album: *Unland* (title under embargo) - scheduled for release in May 2026 (exact date to be confirmed). The first single from the album is called 'Oufti' and will be released on 27/3/26.
